This Tuesday we will also consider the life of David. He was a "man after God's own heart." He loved the Lord and the Lord loved him. He defeated Goliath and was praised by the people of God. Saul, the King of Israel loved him! But when Saul discerned that David would be the next in line for the throne, he sought to have David killed. David went from being a hero to being hunted! His life was in total turmoil; and yet he WAITED for the promises of God! You and I could learn a great deal from him.
